October (1928), Battleship Potemkin (1925), Alexander Nevsky (1938)—
Russian director and writer Sergei Eisenstein's films are the essence of
cinematic and art-historical gravitas. Even Stalin liked him—occasionally.
But Eisenstein had a marvelously dirty imagination as well, as this suite of
"sex drawings" made by the artist between 1931 and 1948—appearing in
the United States for the first time at Alexander Gray Associates—attests.
In this exhibition you'll see a Sadeian chandelier orgy and masked rams
engaging in frottage, among other sights. Perversity flourishes amid even
the most oppressive regimes.
