New York contemporary artist Polly Apfelbaum, who has mounted more than 60 solo exhibitions worldwide during a four-decade career, is known for her colorful textiles, ceramics, works on paper and especially fabric installations. "Waiting for the UFOs (a space set between a landscape and a bunch of flowers)" originated at the Ikon Gallery in Birmingham, England, and has been specially designed for Kemper Museum, which is kicking off its 25th anniversary year.
