Cary S./Candyass Liebowitz assembles a kitsch show of bric-a-brac that commands a double take. Liebowitz's new American calligraphy is filled with jarring yet generic phrases such as "I hate you", "life sucks" and "drop dead". All reminiscent of David Peals' rants from the 60's. These are printed on unexpected forms, felt pennants, miniature baseball bats, etc. This orchestrated exhibition takes a bite out of twentieth century Americana. Liebowitz gives few clues to his kitchy angst, except for his insecurity with being racially correct. Other stock items include rugs, dinner plates, stuffed bears, plus a homo erotic calendar. All bearing Liebowitz's / Candyass wit!
